

AAPC 2008 Conference Application for Scholarship

A limited number of scholarships are available to offset the costs of attending the American Association of Pastoral Counselors Annual Conference in Norfolk, Virginia March 27 – 29, 2008. Scholarships will be sponsored by AAPC Regions and the Annual Conference to further the Association's goal of encouraging attendance of those not adequately represented in AAPC. Aid is dependent upon funding availability and individual need. Individuals and/or service and training centers may make nominations for those who meet scholarship criteria. Scholarships average \$325.

Eligibility criteria for Association conference scholarships are: **1)** You have no other continuing or professional education funds available; **2)** submit a written reference from an AAPC member who oversees the work of the candidate and is familiar with and can attest to his/her financial need and circumstances; **3)** indicate the need for financial aid, if applicable; and **4)** are current with AAPC dues.

The following information will assist you in determining costs when submitting your application. (Meal and ground transportation allotments are based on AAPC policies.)

- *Full conference- \$275; Students/Seminarians- \$185* (Includes opening, plenary sessions, workshops, annual meeting, social events, banquet)

- Or Fri., Or Sat. (Indicate day, and whether attending *plenary only* or full day):
Plenary only: AAPC member/Samaritan, \$55; Others, \$65
Or full day: AAPC member/Samaritan, \$140; Others \$160

- Sat. evening closing banquet: \$45 (*when registering for Friday or Saturday only*)

- Pre-Conference Workshops: Full day: \$110; Half-day: \$55

- Norfolk Waterside Marriott Hotel group rate: \$114/night; with tax \$129.82 *

- Meal allotment: \$35 per day

- If driving, base ground transportation on 30 cents per mile

- Airfare (search web sites to determine estimated costs)

Application due date is February 1. Applications will be considered on a first come, first served basis.

* To save on hotel expenses, you may wish to consider a roommate. E-mail requests to the AAPC Office (AAPCconference@aapc.org), subject line: "AAPC Conference Roommate," and include name, address, e-mail, day/evening phone numbers, arrival and departure dates, gender, smoker or non-smoker, whether you will share a room with a smoker, and other pertinent information.
